The Role: Deputy MEP Manager

The **Deputy MEP Manager** will assist the MEP Manager in managing the design and coordination of Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) systems for Company's projects. Key Responsibilities

1. Technical & Design Support

- Provide specialized input on all related MEP components (electrical, HVAC, plumbing, fire protection, ELV systems);
- Support resolution of technical issues to maintain design integrity and performance.

- Participate in design meetings and provide updates on MEP progress;
- Ensure integration of MEP systems with Architectural and Structural elements.

- Review MEP shop drawings, material submittals, and technical documents;
- Maintain accurate records, including project specifications, reports, and as-built documentation;

Key Requirements

- Professional registration in MEP Engineering is a **MUST**.
